Many Christian publishers and websites are publishing ads that entice visitors with provocative images and information—if you click on the ad the landing page is generally far worse. Brothers, we are called, with love and truth, to destroy arguments and every high thing lifting itself up against the knowledge of God, taking captive every thought into the obedience of Christ.

Example #1 - ChristianPost.com

The Christian Post uses an online advertising service called Revcontent, which pays the Christian Post for impressions (views) and click-throughs. These ads make up about 20% of the ads published on their website—but what percentage of ad income do these provocative ads generate? Why would a website calling itself Christian provide demonic snares to God's people?




